

FIELD TRIP DIRECTIONS MONSTESSA PARK, CABQ VECTOR LABORATORY

Google maps directions to Brent Baca Memorial Disc Golf Course, Meeting location is just south of the course.

- 1. Heading South on I-25, take exit 220 to Rio Bravo Blvd SE heading west
- 2. Turn left onto Broadway Blvd SE, continue for 1.8mi
- 3. Turn left onto Bobby Foster Rd
- 4. Turn left onto Los Picaros Rd SE
- 5. Continue passed the Solid Waste Convenience Center
- 6. Take a right before entering the CABQ Parks and Recreation offices
